## Leptosphaeria spring dead spot=Leptosphaerulina leaf blight=NECROTIC RING SPOT

(Leptosphaeria korrae, Leptosphaeria narmari, Leptosphaerulina australis, or Leptosphaerulina trifolii)

Predominately a saprophyte, but can cause root borne disease symptoms on warm season grasses. Can be associated with *Ophiosphaerella herpotricha* and *Gaeumannomyces graminis var. graminis*.

Temperature ranges 50-68°F (10-20°C) for *L. narmari*; optimum 77°F (25°C) (range 68-82°F or 20-28°C) for *L. korrae*. Growth cessation below 50°F or above 86°F. Pathogens are ectotrophic, runner hyphae and attack primarily the roots, stolons, crowns, and rhizomes of grasses, with infection beginning during the mid-fall time frame. Disseminated by mechanical means (vertical cutting, cultivation/aeration).

<u>Symptoms:</u> 6-12-inch circular, semicircular or serpentine sunken patches of light tan/straw colored grass blades. Pockmarked or doughnut-shaped appearance with matted turf plants containing a tuft of apparently healthy turf in the center=frog-eye effect. Areas can expand up to 40 inches in diameter on older turf (2+ years after planting).
